She received her doctorate in Cultural Psychology from Boston College. Her teaching interests include psychological differences between Asians and Westerners (in particular Japanese and North Americans), cultural influence on the self, emotion, and cognition, and the impact of social oppression on the psychology of both the advantaged and disadvantaged group members. Her research interests include investigating factors that lead people to take collective action (i.e. demonstrations and protests), qualitative research on life histories of people who become allies to minority groups. She currently teaches courses in Cultural Psychology, Psychology of Discrimination, Psychology of Positionality: Understanding Majority Privilege, and a seminar in Qualitative Research Methods in Psychology.
